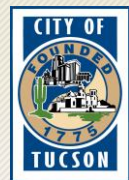

Corridor Overview and Status

Silverbell Corridor, Ina Road to Grant Road, 3 Phases

Phase 1 - Grant to Goret

- Construction complete by December 2016

Phase 2 - Goret to El Camino del Cerro

- Design Underway
- Planning and investigation of cultural resources – 2 years
- Anticipated construction – early 2019

Phase 3 - El Camino del Cerro to Ina

- Design to begin approximately 2022

Project Timeline



Design Features

- 4-lane divided roadway with raised median
- Bike lanes
- 10-ft asphalt multi-use path continuous on east side
- Rubber blend in new asphalt roadway to mitigate noise
- New drainage culverts which can be used by wildlife
- Traffic signal improvements at El Camino del Cerro and Sweetwater
- LED street lighting
- Native landscaping and water harvesting
- Public art
- Retaining walls with natural architectural finish
