

On Monday, October 24, Tuesday, October 25 and Wednesday, October 26, 2016, from 5 a.m. and 5 p.m. each day, Hunter Contracting will begin final paving on Silverbell Road from Grant to Goret Roads. Residents and the traveling public should expect the following restrictions and delays:

Monday, October 24, 5 a.m. to 5 p.m.

- When the outside lane (curb lane) of Silverbell Road is paved, motorists entering and exiting side streets should expect delays of 20 to 50 minutes* while paving equipment moves though the intersections.
 See below for <u>approximate</u> start times for paving activities at each street:
 - o Goret Road (west side), 8:10 a.m.
 - o Cerrada Del Beto, 8:30 a.m.
 - o Xochi Pilli Drive, 8:55 a.m.
 - o Prichett Place, 9:40 a.m.
 - o Silver Vista Place, 10:05 a.m.
 - Silver Sun Drive, 11:40 a.m.
 - Painted Sunset Circle, 3:25 p.m.
- Paving in front of Burlwood Way and Frostwood Lane will begin at 2:30 p.m. One access point into the subdivision will remain open at all times.
- Flaggers will be on site to help direct traffic through the work area.

** There will be no access in or out of side streets as the paving operations move through the intersection. Motorists should plan travel accordingly to account for delays.**

Tuesday, October 25, 5 a.m. to 5 p.m.

 When the outside lane (curb lane) of Silverbell Road is paved, motorists entering and exiting side-streets should expect delays of 20 to 50 minutes while paving equipment moves though the intersections.
See below for approximate start times for paving activities at each street:

- Paving in front of Silver Arrow Drive and Silver Bell Tree Drive will begin at 6:55 a.m.
 One access point into the subdivision will remain open at all times.
- Goret Road (east side), 8:15 a.m.
- When the inside lane (median lane) of Silverbell Road is paved:
 - Left turn movements will be restricted into and out of side streets as needed for paving operations.
 - Right turns will be permitted at all times.
- Flaggers will be on site to direct motorists through the work zone.

There will be no access in or out of side streets as the paving operations move through the intersection. Motorists should plan travel accordingly to account for delays.

Wednesday, October 26, 5 a.m. to 5 p.m.

- When the inside lane (median lane) of Silverbell Road is paved:
 - Left turn movements will be restricted into and out of side streets as needed for paving operations.
 - Right turns will be permitted at all times.
- Flaggers will be on site to direct motorists through the work zone.
- Motorists should plan travel accordingly to account for delays.

Following the new alignment paving, the contractor will also pave the Goret Road/Silverbell Road Intersection and all side street entrances along Silverbell Road between Grant and Goret Roads. This work is scheduled **5 a.m. to 5 p.m. each day beginning Friday, October 28, through Wednesday, November 2, 2016.** For more information, please watch for an updated traffic alert.

**Please note that business access will be maintained at all times.
